4th Carolina Crusher 4

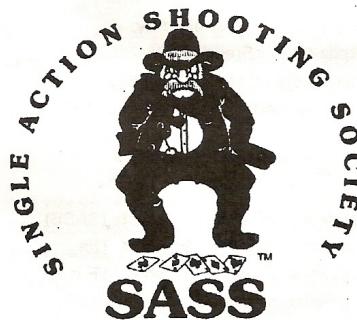
