COWBOY ACTION

2nd Annual Four Corners Long Range Buffalo Shoot

I don't know if the fuel costs kept some of the shooters at home but we had a great shoot with the 16 that showed up. Friday's weather was nothing to brag about but it didn't seem to affect the lever action matches much. Tom Horn was the only timed match, 3 shots at 200 yds.

The results:

1st. Blanco Billy Bagley with 3 hits in 11.96 sec.

2nd. Ole Wise SASS 3 hits in 107.05 sec. (His rifle jammed so he had to clear it to continue).

3rd. Buckshot Randy 2 hits in 23.82 sec.

The Long Range Lever action involved 5 shots each at 220 yds., 330 yds. and 424 yds.

1st. O Bar Freddie 12 hits

2nd. Les Likely 10 hits (She bested Blanco Billy in a shootoff.)

3rd. Blanco Billy Bagley 10 hits

Saturday was overcast but not much wind and the single shot scores showed it. After the 30 shot match we had a 3 shot Quiquley at 492 yds. Four shooters were tied at 2 hits, so another shootoff. The first round, one shooter missed. Second round the second shooter missed, giving him third. Four more rounds and Drew Lefty and O Bar Freddie were still tied, neither having missed. The sixth round they decided to shoot the 750 yd grizzly. O Bar lucked a shot in and Drew kicked up dirt.

Officer's gun goes off during safety class

Mass. (AP) – New Bedford

A firearms instructor in southern Massachusetts has been assigned to other duties after his gun accidentally went off while he was teaching a class on weapons safety.

Officials say the Glock handgun discharged while Maj. Donald Lamar was demonstrating to Bristol County deputy sheriffs how to safely holster the weapon.

The bullet ripped a hole in Lamar's pants but missed his leg and foot.

Sheriff Thomas Hodgson says the officer made a 'gross error in judgement' by not emptying the gun before class.

Lamar, a certified firearms instructor since 2005, was transferred to another division and will not carry a firearm while the incident is investigated.
