The San Juan County 4-H Shotgun Shooting Team #1
 traveled to the NRA Whittington Center in Raton, NM
 to compete at the NM State 4-H Shooting Competi-
 tion. The weather lived up to it's usual cold, rainy,
 windy self, seen in the past 4 years of competition.

The morning of May 2, the team woke up to 100%
 humidity and 80% visibility. They decided to go
 ahead and shoot because the weather was supposed to
 get worse through out the day. In spite of the heavy
 fog at 8:30 AM, San Juan County's Shot Gun Team
 #1 took the lead immediately, and never looked back,
 winning 1st Place. The team was required to shoot 50
 clay pigeons in trap and 50 clay pigeons in skeet, for a
 total of 100. The team individual and scores are as

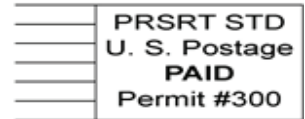
