Myron first started shooting a .22 when he was four years old with his grandfather's help and by six years of age he was hunting squirrels and rabbits. Myron shoots in the Hunter Benchrest competitions and has won *SJWF* club matches as well as the Mid-Continent Regional Match and finished second

in the National Hunter Benchrest competition. Myron's favorite weapons are .22 cal Centerfire Varmint rifles and .25 cal big game rifles. Myron's other passion is big game hunting which began when he shot a whitetail at the age of nine years old. Myron graduated into the *really* big game shooting in 2000, in which he's shot Kudu, BushBuck, Impala, Baboons, Leopard, Cape Buffalo, WaterBuck, Eland, Sable, Nyala, Wart Hog, Lion, Gemsbok, SpringBuck, StineBuck, Klipspringer, Blesbok and jackels. Myron is planning another trip to Africa in September of 2010 in which he will be hunting elephant.

Myron first moved to the SJC area in 1954 and went to work for EPNG.

Myron has been married for 51 years to Lola Marie, has two sons and three grandsons. Myron retired from full-time employment in 1993 but can often be found at East Main Trade where he works Mondays and Fridays.

Myron states he has enjoyed being a member of *SJWF*, engaging in shooting competitions and the fellowship with club members. He is a fascinating individual and stories of his Africa trips are very interesting to hear about.
