NEW AIM PROGRAM APPROVED BY SJWF BOARD

SJWF life member, Patrick Drake Sr., who is also a member of the American Trap Association, has proposed a trial program of the ATA's youth program, AIM (Academics-Integrity-Marksmanship). The program is focused on encouraging more youth to take up and participate in the shotgun sports. Participating in this new program will involve kids 11 to 23 years old, in registered competition, competing individually and on teams. Coaching in this ATA-sponsored program requires certified NRA/ATA coaches. Mr. Drake has 4 people certified and ready to go. The pro-

gram will start this first year with 15 youth to allow the coaches to run safe and controlled events as they learn this new program. As experience is gained, and more coaches are trained, more youth will be added next year. Their ability to run larger events, just as safely controlled, will be achieved. The hope is, that this AIM program will provide a valuable service to the community, and give the youth in our area another sport to help expend their energy, fill their free time, and help them stay out of trouble. At the same time they will enrichen their lives with a new, fun and wholesome hobby, and learn worthwhile real skills, far away from their pseudo lives in computer games.—gs
