PISTOL RANGE TIPS

I'm thinking (borrowing from the movie "Cool Hand Luke") that we may have a failure to communicate. You see we have these great pistol ranges open to members, and the club even bought a whole bunch of nice target stands to set up targets to shoot, yet there are those who seem to prefer to shoot everything else, like props built for the pistol shooting sports events, the tables (wire spools), the porta potties, and now someone even shot out the windows of the station wagon (fig. 1) parked for the use of pistol shooting sports events!



Maybe there are members who don't understand how fun and easy it is to have a great time shooting pistol, using the supplied shooting stands. So here's a little tutorial for them.:

First, gather the things you need to take to the range (fig.2), besides your pistol and ammo. That would



be: A 2'x2' piece of cardboard and/or targets. A stapler, a roll of masking tape, and two 4' long 1x2 boards. (the boards make the vertical target supports, that drop-in the supplied steel bases, and are tightened with a thumb screw. It's really cheap and easy to buy a 1x2 (3/4"x1-1/2") 8' long at Home Depot (costs about \$5.50 even for select wood) and cut the board in half with a hand saw.

Second, Go to the range and set up your targets (fig. 3), by dropping the two 4' long 1x2's into the slots in one of the club's many



target support stands. Screw the set screws tight, then staple a target to the uprights.



Then tear off a long strip of masking tape, and stick just the top inch to one of the 1x2 supports.

(one can then tear off a little piece of the dangling tape to cover bullet holes, so you can keep shooting the



target over and over again. -gs
