## BYLAW CHANGES APPROVED

The proposed bylaw changes redefining membership classes and dues remuneration was approved by majority vote at the general membership club meeting on November 15, 2011.

**Dues** are now to be paid in legal tender only. No barter, trade or other methods.

**Purchased Life Memberships** will be no more as of January 1, 2012.

**Bestowed Life Memberships**, an honor bestowed by the Board of Directors to reward (and encourage) exceptional and meritorious service to the Club. Such bestowed life memberships shall be for the natural life of the member.

**Existing life members** including those purchased before January 1st, shall be grandfathered in and recognized as valid for the natural life of those members.

**Seniors Membership discounts** are discontinued as of January 1. **NRA DISCOUNT STILL APPLIES**

The bylaws will read:

**Article III: Members Section 1 Membership** (Membership classes are (1) Annual, and (2) Life.

Annual memberships are for one (1) year from date of acceptance or renewal.

Life memberships are for the natural life of the member and are awarded by the Board of Directors for exceptional and meritorious service to the Club.

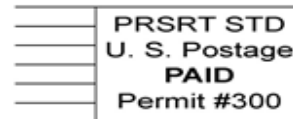
