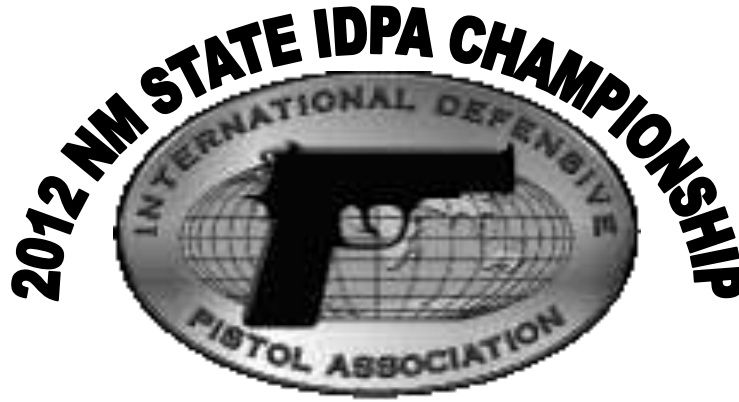

The San Juan Wildlife Federation & the San Juan Defensive Pistol Association are pleased to host the 2012 New Mexico State International Defensive Pistol Association Championship.

The entire pistol Range will be closed on Thursday the 23rd through Saturday the 25th of August for this event. The San Juan Defensive Pistol Association (SJDPA) has been affiliated with The International Defensive Pistol Association (IDPA) since October 2000. SJDPA is a chance to practice Defensive shooting skills in a competitive environment. Visitors are welcome. Come and watch. Perhaps you'll find you'd like to participate in IDPA!

Shooters are divided into four firearm divisions, depending on action type and caliber. Shooters compete in five different classifications, based on skill level. A special 90 round classification match is held three times per year and additional classifiers as necessary. In a match you compete only against shooters in the same division and classification.

Notice: Because of this State Shoot, the regularly scheduled shoot on September 2 has been canceled.

JUNIOR SPORTER AIR RIFLE FALL LEAGUE

The Sporter Air Rifle League will be conducted at the SJWF indoor range and will held during the months of September to December.

The Sporter Air Rifle League has three divisions, Junior, Intermediate and Sub-junior. The Junior Division consists of eligible participants from 18 to 20 years old. The Intermediate division of 15 to 17 year olds. The Sub-junior of 8 to 14 year olds. Participants under the age of 15 must be accompanied by an adult.

Participants may use air rifles provided by the San Juan Wildlife Federation or may choose to use their own air rifle as long as it complies with the specifications in the Sporter Air Rifle Position Rule Book. Pellets and targets are provided by the SJWF. **Fee is \$5.00 per shooter per match.**

The matches will be held in the evening on a day of the week to be determined unless otherwise noted in the SJWF Match Schedule. Each match will consist of 10 rounds in each of the standing, kneeling, sitting and prone positions. Fifteen minutes will be allowed for the prone position and 20 minutes for each of the other positions. Five minutes will be allowed for scoring of each position's targets and 5 minutes will be allowed for each change of position.

The organizational meeting will be held at 6:30 P.M., August 19, 2012 at the SJWF club house. The entrance to SJWF is off the Bloomfield Hwy just west of the Sinclair station on the north side of the highway. Any changes to the match rules, day and times will be discussed at this meeting. in your membership dues 30 days prior to the expiration date on your newsletter address label in order to avoid any interruption in your membership.

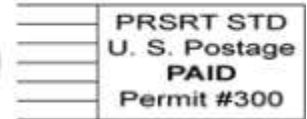
