ON THE COMING ELECTRONIC NEWSLETTER

Last issue's Letter to Members, we indicated that **May's newsletter would be the last paper newsletter mailed to each member.** For June and subsequent issues, **The newsletter will be available only at:**

www.sjwf.org/newsletter.htm

Quoting from last issue's letter: "A major expense is the printed Newsletter. We are currently spending nearly \$9,000 per year, to print and mail out paper copies of the monthly newsletter, which is already published and available to members a week earlier on the sjwf.org website." So the board and officers elected to do away with that major expense, since it is already available to members on the club's internet site.

Some may not even be aware we have a web site for the club, let alone realize the newsletters (including archives) are there. There are three ways to view the newsletter quickly:

1. Type in "www.sjwf.org" and <enter> then click on the "Newsletter" choice in the menu, or
2. Type in "www.sjwf.org/newsletter.htm" to go to the page directly, or
2. Just Google "sjwf.org" and choose "newsletter" from the choices listed below.

Once there, click on the month you want and the Newsletter is presented in .pdf format. **At the top left of the .pdf file page is a "print" menu. Click it and you can print out the Newsletter in color on your ink jet printer.**

Please understand that the **Newsletter will NOT be mailed or emailed to each member.**

It's simple to add the newsletter to your browser's toolbar, and you will have it one-click available 24/7. If you can't do that a lot of us just ask our kids, grand kids, a fellow worker or neighbor to do it for you. Takes about 30 seconds.

Quoting again from the letter, "We understand the value of our newsletter. Besides keeping members informed of news and events, it is also used as a reminder of membership renewal dates."

Another quote from the letter, "As for renewal reminders, we will send reminders to members via e-mail, to all those who have given us addresses. If you have not already done so, or want to make sure that we have your e-mail address, send an email to security@sjwf.org and in the subject line put "**address update**". You will be added to the data base and a renewal reminder will be sent to you 30 days prior to your membership expiration".

Those email addresses we have requested from the membership are for renewal notification purposes only.
