In the CMP Rimfire event the team came in 4th and Michaela came in 7th individual. In the 3P event the team placed 3rd with Amoret McCartney placing 9th with her individual score. For the overall team award, the San Juan County .22 team ranked 4th in the Nation with Rashel Korte ranking 9th overall. Congratulations to all the shooters at state.
